Update on Resource Sufficiency Evaluation Enhancements

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The ISO is proposing to enhance the accuracy of the resource sufficiency evaluation during the first phase of the initiative

The proposal incorporates stakeholder input to:

- Ensure the test only evaluates and counts capacity that is made available to the EIM for use
- Ensure only imports with high certainty of delivery are counted
- Ensures the evaluation is applied equitably between entities who base schedule and the ISO

Propose that DMM assume all resource sufficiency evaluation reporting and metric development

- Avoids the appearance of conflict of the ISO having oversight of the test since it is an EIM participant
- DMM will report on all aspects of resource sufficiency evaluation
 - Natural fit as DMM already does significant reporting on the RSE as part of their review of the real-time market
 - DMM will be in charge of development of all metrics. ISO will assist in posting of DMM developed real-time metrics
 - DMM will preform quarterly EIM Governing Body updates
- The ISO will provide additional data via customer market results interface on advisory and binding results
 - Allows entities to better engage with test and spot check evaluation results



Expanded DMM role in monitoring and reporting on resource sufficiency test performance and issues.

- Special monthly reporting beginning in September
 - Aimed at providing quicker feedback on performance
 - Additional information in quarterly reports
- DMM will work with stakeholders and ISO on development of reporting metrics and analysis
 - Standardized metrics for all BAAs and ISO
 - Provision of detailed underlying data to participants
 - Analysis of potential changes in how requirement and available supply which are being discussed in stakeholder process
- Enhanced informational reporting to the EIM Governing Body
